

Where Do the Candidates Stand on Life?

Abortion

Thom Tillis



Thom Tillis is pro-life. He opposes abortion on demand, and supports protection for unborn children. Thom Tillis supports the bill to protect unborn children from abortion after 20 weeks, when they are capable of experiencing excruciating pain during abortions.

Thom Tillis provided crucial pro-life leadership as Speaker of the North Carolina House to enact a record number of pro-life laws. **Kay Hagan** supports a policy of abortion on demand for any reason. Kay Hagan opposes the bill that would protect unborn children from abortion after 20 weeks, when they are capable of experiencing excruciating pain during abortions.

Kay Hagan has voted against pro-life interests 100 percent of the time on votes scored by National Right to Life.

Obamacare Health Care Law

Thom Tillis opposes the Obamacare law, and he is committed to help reverse the abortion-expanding and rationing effects of that law.

Kay Hagan voted to enact the pro-abortion, prorationing Obamacare law.

Taxpayer Funding for Abortion

Thom Tillis opposes using federal funds to pay for abortion.

Kay Hagan voted to spend federal funds on health plans that pay for abortion on demand (12/08/09, Roll Call No. 369).

Parental Notice Before Abortion

Thom Tillis supports requiring parental notice before an abortion is performed on a minor daughter.

Kay Hagan voted against requiring an abortionist to notify a parent before performing an abortion on a minor girl who has crossed state lines to obtain the abortion (3/22/13, Roll Call No. 64).

Conscience Rights

Thom Tillis supports exempting institutions or individuals from purchasing coverage for services that violate their religious or moral convictions.

Kay Hagan voted to further empower the Obama Administration to mandate health coverage of the abortion pill RU-486, surgical abortion (including late abortions), or anything else it classifies as "preventive services," overriding all existing federal laws that protect religious freedom and conscience rights (S. 2578, 7/16/14, Roll Call No. 228).
